

New Rail Fence

Simple, scrappy and oh so easy to make. The key is keeping the middle strip light and dark accents on the sides of this strip the same for all of the blocks. The pattern uses two other fabrics in each block, but this would also be great if all these were different fabrics. -

Fabrics required for 1 block

- 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished
- Dark - Black & white strips in pic
- 2 - 1 ½" x 12 ½"
- Centre strip 5 ½" x 12 ½"
- Bright #1 - 2 - 3 ½" squares
- Bright #2 - 2 - 3 ½" squares & 2 ½" x 12 ½"

Fabrics for 30 block quilt

60" x 72"

Dark 1.5m

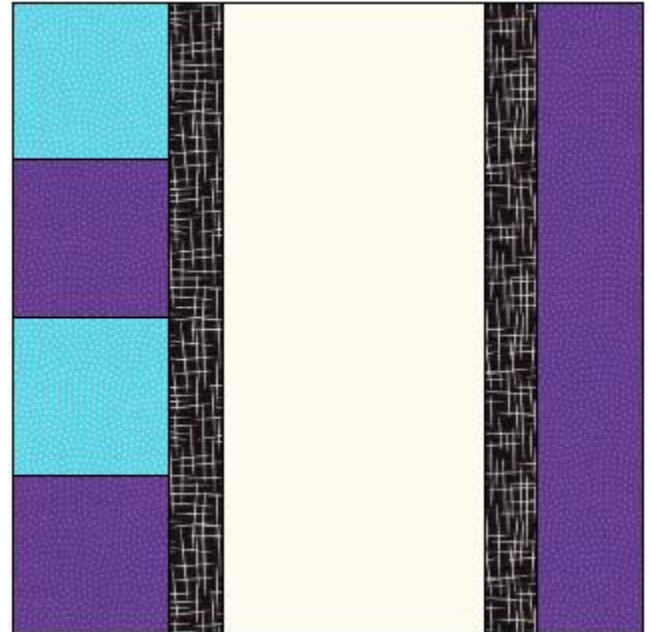
- Cut 3 - 12 ½" x WOF sub cut into 60 - 1 ½" x 12 1/2"
- Cut 7 - 2 ½" x WOF for binding

Background 1.6m

- Cut 5 - 12 ½" x WOF sub cut into 30 - 5 ½" x 12 1/2"

Scraps

- Bright #1 - 30 x 2 - 3 ½" squares
- Bright #2 - 30 x 2 - 3 ½" squares & 2 ½" x 12 ½"
- Or
- 120 - 3 ½" squares & 13 - 2 ½" x 12 ½"



Assembly is easy, press seams open for only the left square strip if making a single block. This will help with matching seams during assembly.

If making a quilt, press seams in the square strip to one direction for 15 blocks and the other direction for the other 15. Alternate these when laying out the blocks, so seams interlock.
